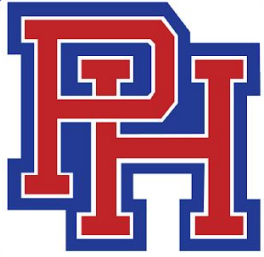
Gymnastics
